support to the anticipated 9th IMG to be held in Cheboksary next year and so forth.

Lest October 8. Sports Minister of Chavesh Republic proposed the opinion to the IMCC HQs that it would be better to determine the 9th IMC date as the pandemic situation would be eased in Russia.

The event organized as a continental event after the pandemic spread of Covid-19 was attended by 864 athletes from 25 countries in Europe. In the opening ceremony held at a new stadium of Heraklion "Dio Arokia" were present Vice Minister Lepteris Avgenakis of Greece Culture and Sports Ministry, ITF President Prof. Ri Yong Son, EITF President GM. Michael Prewette and representatives of Crete Region.









International Jendo Federation (IJF) in collaboration with the NMGC Philippines proposed the IMGC HQs to host Asia Pacific Martial Arts Games in Philippines either in 2023 or 2024 as soon as global health crisis will be over.

IMGC welcomed the proposal with the approval of IMGC Executive Board members and agreed to send the HQs staff to Philippines at an appropriate time.


