Trainers and Referees Seminar was held in May, 2022 in Syria by World Federation of Kowat Alrami and Self Defence.






MARTIAL ARTS FEDERATION

The 8th NMGC GAMES 2022 was held in the City of Mandaluyong, Philippines in November, 2022.




The 11th International Sqay Masters Cup 2022 concluded at Phalgham club of Kashmir in which 5 countries participated.

On 16th September, 2022 Dr. Paul G. Hoglund, Vice President of IMGC and President of World Jiu-Jitsu Confederation passed away at the age of 82.

He was one of the founders of Swedish Budo Federation, World Union of Karatedo Organizations, European Kung Fu Union, World Judo Federation, World Jiu-Jitsu Confederation and he worked as the president of several martial arts organizations.

He was elected as Vice President of IMGC at the 8th Congress of IMGC in New Delhi on 3rd December, 2015 and took an active part in the development of martial arts on an international scale.

His exploits made in building a justifiable and peaceful world under the ideal of friendship, cooperation and development will remain forever with IMGC.
