The IMGC EB meeting was held on 20th August, 2023 in Astana, Kazakhstan.

According to the decision of the IMGC EB meeting held on 20th August, 2023 in Astana, Kazakhstan, the 9th IMG is going to be held in October, 2024 in Tashkent, Uzbekistan.

The 22nd ITF Taekwon-Do World Championships were held from the 18th to 26th August, 2023 in Astana, the capital city of Kazakhstan.

In the opening ceremony held on the 19th August, Yerlan Becuburjaev, Vice Minister of education, sports and culture of Kazakhstan Republic and Ri Yong Son, the ITF President made congratulatory speeches and then performance of Kazakh artists and Taekwon-Do demonstration of DPR Korea Taekwon-Do demonstration team were held.

The championships in which more than 1300 players and officials from 73 countries took part in were held in cadets, juniors, seniors and veteran categories and the DPR Korea, Russia and Greece took 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in overall rankings of countries respectively.
