

IMCC ED meeting held

The IMGC EB meeting was held at IMGC HQ in Pyongyang, the capital city of DPR Korea on 17th June.

Along with them Master Laziz Khasanov, President of the Organizing Committee of the 9th IMG and his team members, Mr. Kim Yong II, Chief Director of IMAF, directors of IMAF and officials of IMGC HQ took part in the meeting as observers.


Attendants of the Memorial Service for the 22nd

The founder of Jiyutaido is Mr. Azizov Teyub (Azerbaijan) and the present President is Hanshi Jimmy Leslie (Latvia).

IJF was founded in Baku, Azerbaijan in March, 2008.
